WHITE WINES

Grillo Chardonnay, Sicily, Italy (House White) £3.65 | £4.95 | £13.95
From the west coast of Sicily, this wine is specially sourced and blended for Loch Fyne. Great with all seafood especially shellfish.

Domaine Begude Chardonnay, France £15.85
This Chardonnay is made according to traditional methods by the young English winemaker James Kinglake.

Kumi Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa £4.45 | £5.95 | £16.95
Crisp and zesty with citrus fruit flavours.

Gros Plant du Nantais, France, £4.45 | £5.95 | £16.95
This wine has been bottled just for Loch Fyne since 1989. A dry, sharp wine which is perfect with our oysters and shellfish.

Ormarine Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France £4.45 | £5.95 | £16.95
Trendy, aromatic, citrus-flavoured wine from the South of France. Great with seafood and lighter dishes.

Closheim Riesling, Nahe, Germany £17.45
This wine is zesty and aromatic with lime and mineral flavours. Great with light fish dishes and shellfish.

Santa Carolina Viognier, Colchagua, Chile £4.65 | £6.25 | £17.95
Ripe stone fruit flavours and perfume. Matches perfectly with the richness of lobster or mussels.

Savino Pinot Grigio, Italy £4.70 | £6.45 | £18.45
Dry with crisp citrus fruit flavours. The crispness makes it a perfect match for our fish and chips.

Domaine des Dorices Muscadet, Loire Valley, France £4.70 | £6.45 | £18.45
A dry, crisp wine from a producer who uses no chemicals in his growing and vinification techniques.

Loimer Grüner Veltliner, Kamptal, Austria £20.95
This bio-dynamic wine is dry with stone fruit notes, white pepper and spice. Superb with prawn dishes.

Pionero Albarino, Rías Baixas, Spain £21.95
Bone dry with vibrant peachy flavours and a nice touch of minerality. Great with scallops.

Pascal Bouchard Chablis, France £6.50 | £8.60 | £24.95
From a small family Domaine this wine is lean with green apple and citrus flavours.

Awatere Pass Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand £6.65 | £8.95 | £25.95
Great texture, with layers of tropical and citrus fruits. The grapes are sourced from the cooler Awatere valley, giving the wine a crisp freshness with a touch of steely minerality.

WHITE WINES CONTINUED

Domaine Brochard Sancerre, Loire Valley, France £26.75
The Brochard family have been making wine in Sancerre since the 16th century. The classic mellow, herbaceous expression of Sauvignon.

Jean Durup Chablis Premier Cru Fourchaume, France £29.95
A complex Chablis with citrus fruits and mineral notes. A great match for lobster, grilled fish and cheese.

Domaine Brochard Pouilly-Fumé, Loire Valley, France £29.95
Classic Pouilly Fumé with lime and citrus notes along with smoky complexity. A good accompaniment to spicier dishes.

RED WINES

Nero d’Avola Shiraz, Sicily Italy (House Red) £3.65 | £4.95 | £13.95
Warming and intense, this wine is sourced and blended exclusively for Loch Fyne. Red and black fruit flavours combine with subtle hints of spice. Excellent with steaks or on its own.

La Folia Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina £14.95
Vibrant blackcurrant fruits, chunky and solid. This wine goes perfectly with steak.

Santa Carolina Syrah, Chile £16.95
Generous fruits with some pepper and spice complexity. Smooth and easy to drink.

Bodegas Larchago Rioja, Spain £4.95 | £6.55 | £18.75
From one of the oldest wine producers in the region. This wine is full and fruity, a modern type of Rioja.

Awatere Pass Merlot, North Island, New Zealand £5.50 | £7.30 | £20.95
Produced exclusively for Loch Fyne, this wine is rich with ripe plum and mulberry with hints of spice from the oak.

Awatere Pass Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand £26.95
Soft, silky ripe-cherry and raspberry flavours with spiced vanilla. Low tannins makes this a red that works very well with fish.

Clos de L’Oratoire Châteauneuf du Pape, France £29.95
Classic traditional Châteauneuf from a great producer. Full bodied, rich and intense with jam, spice and herbs.

Baron de Ley Rioja, Gran Reserva, Spain £29.95
An elegant Gran Reserva Rioja from one of the best producers of the region. Smooth and complex with notes of red berry and vanilla.

ROSÉ WINES

Rosé, Sicily, Italy £3.65 | £4.95 | £13.95
Exclusive to Loch Fyne. A crisp refreshing wine with crushed raspberry fruit flavours.

Savino Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy £17.95
Dry, crisp and clean with strawberry and stone fruit flavours.

St Tropez Rosé, Provence, France £19.95
Lovely, fresh fruity wine from the south of France with a mineral herby touch.

SPARKLING WINES AND CHAMPAGNES

Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut NV, Champagne, France £6.35 | £18.00 | £35.00
Aged for a minimum of three years to produce a soft, delicate flavour with citrus and brioche notes. Great on its own or with shellfish.

Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Rosé NV, Champagne, France £42.00
This rosé has a full, long finish yet is beautifully delicate with raspberry fruits.

Pol Roger Vintage, France (1999/2000) £54.95
From Winston Churchill’s favourite Champagne House – this Pol Roger is elegant with an intense, balanced finish. Vintage subject to change.

Le Contesse Prosecco Brut, Italy £4.00 | £21.00
Refreshingly crisp and aromatic with well-balanced pure fruit flavours of the finest Prosecco grapes.
